### Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

Homelium Care Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 in line with UK Government policy.

As a provider of domiciliary care services, we recognise that our environmental impact arises primarily from staff travel between client visits and the energy used within our office operations. We are committed to implementing practical measures that reduce emissions while continuing to deliver high-quality care to the communities we support.

**Scope 1:** Direct emissions from owned or controlled sources. Homelium does not currently operate company-owned vehicles, therefore Scope 1 emissions are minimal.

**Scope 2:** Indirect emissions from purchased electricity used in office premises.

**Scope 3:** Other indirect emissions including staff travel between care visits, business travel, procurement of goods and services, and operational activities. The majority of emissions arise from staff travel between care visits, which is inherent to the provision of domiciliary care services.

### Carbon Reduction Measures

Homelium has implemented several environmental management measures including:

### **Travel Reduction**

- Scheduling carers within local geographic areas to minimise travel distances
- Encouraging efficient route planning between visits
- Promoting walking or cycling where possible

### **Digital Systems**

- Use of digital care planning systems
- Electronic rostering and documentation
- Reduced reliance on printed documentation

### **Energy Efficiency**

- Monitoring electricity consumption within office premises
- Use of energy-efficient equipment and lighting

### **Sustainable Procurement**

- Preference for suppliers who demonstrate environmental responsibility
- Reduction of single-use materials where possible

### **Future Carbon Reduction Initiatives**

Homelium plans to introduce additional measures including:

- Encouraging car sharing where appropriate
- Exploring the feasibility of electric vehicles for business travel
- Continued reduction of paper usage through digital systems
- Monitoring emissions annually and reviewing reduction opportunities
